

## **NSS ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18**

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The authorities of the Pravara Institute of Medical Sciences have given the permission to start the NSS in PIMS DU, Loni from this Academic year. From the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra with reference letter no. NSS 2017/C.No.87/17/SE-7 dated 20 June 2017 given the permission to start NSS strength of 500 Volunteers for the academic year 2017-18. Accordingly NSS Advisory Committee of PIMS DU was constituted and the first meeting of the committee was conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2017. In this meeting was resolved to start the NSS unit of 200 volunteers (one unit of 50volunteers in four colleges) in PIMS DU.

NSS has given us the platform to serve the society and bring happiness and smile on many faces. We created a hub to deliver services to the society by showcasing our talents. We started our enrollment procedure for the current academic year in the month of October 2017 and 200 hundred students joined as a NSS volunteers for the Academic year 2017-18.

The activities of the NSS for the Academic year 2017-18 began with the NSS foundation day on 24-09-2017 with the theme “Swacchata Hi Sewa” NSS unit has celebrate with the theme “Hand washing for disease prevention”. During this activity demonstration of Hand washing was given and also organize Essay/ video making/ poster competition among the NSS volunteers. The NSS unit of Rural Medical College organized a Blood Donation Drive on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2017 in the Blood bank of Pravara Rural Hospital, Loni. They collected 113 bottles of blood, saving many lives! Rural Medical College also observes the World Aids Week During 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> December 2017 and conducts activity like Lecture on Aids from the department of Community Medicine to the patients and their relatives. RMC NSS volunteers also sensitize school going students with the video on “how to behave with HIV patients”. Volunteers also gave very basic and must know information about prevention of AIDS to the migratory workers at Sugar factory area of PDVVPS karkhana, Pravaranagar.

For the Special camps four colleges have selected four villages. Rural medical college Loni select village Chandrapur, Rural Dental College selects village Durgapur, APJAK college of Physiotherapy selects village Galnimb and College of Nursing selects the village Tisgaon Wadi.

College of Nursing organized the Special camp in the village Tisgaon Wadi during 15<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> January 2018. The theme of the camp was “Youth against Dirt and Disease”. To achieve this they conducted activities like Nutrition Exhibition, General health check up, health survey, Dental check up, Gram Swacchata Abhiyan, Geriatric care, tree plantation, Poster exhibition etc.

APJAK College of Physiotherapy organizes special camp at village Galnimb during 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. They conducts activities like Health promotion, Physical activity awareness, public awareness about Physiotherapy, Blood pressure screening camp, Arthritis check camp etc.

Rural Medical College organizes special camp at village Chandrapur during 10<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. They conduct activities like health exhibition, mini health check up camp, health survey of villagers, first aid on snake bite and poisoning, Yoga demonstrations, menstrual hygiene, trekking to Nizarneshwar for the cleanliness (Plastic free) of the hill etc.

Rural Dental College organizes the special camp at Village Durgapur during 23<sup>rd</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2018 and conducts activities like Oral health check up and Treatment camp, Tobacco awareness rally, Tobacco household survey, personal hygiene, Tree plantation etc.

Motivational lectures and orientation programme are one of the important activities to guide and motivate the NSS volunteers. Such programmes were arranged regularly in every camp and volunteers gained knowledge of activities and social work being carried out.

Besides these all activities our all four Programme Officers were enrolled and successfully completed the orientation programme from NSS Training & Orientation Centre, Ahmednagar.

As per the guidelines of the NSS, a working committee and an advisory committee was helped and monitored the activities of NSS units.
