NSS Special Camp

As a part of NSS special village camp, Adgoan village was selected by the NSS units of PIMS University. All the four units i.e. Rural Medical College (RMC), Rural Dental College (RDC), Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam College of Physiotherapy and College of Nursing participated in the camp. Day 1

Session 1:

Cleanliness drive: A cleanliness drive was organised wherein all the volunteers cleaned the premises where the camp was to be organised, the school premises, the ZP premises and many other surroundings areas in the village.
